

Procedures for IPA members applying for SCAAK membership

SCAAK Recognition membership level to IPA members

Associate membership of the IPA (AIPA) are eligible to apply for Accountant Technicians of SCAAK.

FIPA and MIPA members are eligible to apply for SCAAK membership as:

- Certified Auditor,
- Certified Accountant,
- Public Sector Certified Auditor and
- Internal Certified Auditor
- Statutory Auditor¹

SCAAK Membership Criteria

An individual shall be eligible for a full membership if he/she:

- 1. Is a member of Institute of Public Accountants (IPA)
- 2. Can prove the relevant working experience, in accordance with SCAAK's Practical Experience Requirement for certain level of SCAAK's Certification Program
- 3. University degree
- 4. Has passed the examination on Commercial, Labour and Tax laws of Kosovo at SCAAK
- 5. Has a clear background in possession of high professional and ethical standards
- 6. Is not convicted of a criminal offence during his/her professional engagement
- 7. The candidate should provide a certificate that he/she is not under investigation

Documents and Application Forms required by SCAAK

To apply for membership in SCAAK candidates must apply via e-mail sherbimiperanetare@scaak.org and attaching the following documents:

- Letter of good standing from the IPA;
- Certificate with transcript of the applicant's academic and professional qualifications;
- Application form (Find Attached) and
- Work reference letter and CV

 $^{^{1}}$ Statutory Auditor is a practical license issued by Kosovo Council for Financial Reporting - Oversight Board in Kosovo.



Following the finalization of your application, the membership certificate will be issued and send to you via email and post.
